The 2005 Estate Merlot is gorgeous in the glass. Still redolent of wild black cherry a hint of menthol, a whiff of juniper and barrel nuttiness from the fine French oak. This is a big, muscular, meaty and well structured wine. It will pair up with spicy sausages, mighty lamb dishes with superb flavors. And for vegetarians, grilled Portobello mushrooms with arugula and provolone.
