**Vineyard Information:** Our Estate Pinot Noir vines enjoy a southwest exposure at 1600 foot elevation. We grow a mixture of Dijon and Pommard clones which add complexity to the final wine.

#### Tasting Characteristics:

This is a true beauty: burgundy velvet, glistening and gorgeous in the glass. Aromas are perfumey black raspberry with hints of coriander and plum tart. On the palate, the flavors are big, silky raspberry and chocolate with a hint of cherry jam. The tannins are evident, the acidity is perfect and the structure is all there: a very balanced wine. Enjoy this fine, age-worthy wine with rich foods like duck breast or grilled lamb.
