**Vineyard Information:**

The very first release of Petite Sirah comes from the Dellamagorie Vineyard in San Martin, source for the plush and chocolatey Cabernet Sauvignon that forms the core of our ever-popular Old School Cabernet blend.

**Tasting Characteristics:**

The color is so beautiful, with that characteristic blue-purple hue that belies a Petite Sirah. You can almost taste the blueberries even before your first sip. The nose is filled with blueberries and sassafras, with lots of vanilla extract from the new oak, which is quite prominent now. The primary flavors are huckleberries, Santa Rosa Plums, spiced ham, and cranberries, with a nice hit of white pepper and a hint of chervil. This wine will be great with some decanting now, but best 2009 thru 2011.

Right now, it would be nice paired with lean meats like grilled buffalo sirloin, venison with juniper and cherries, or a stew of pork, white beans, dinosaur chard, chervil, and coriander. Or just go ahead and indulge in a baked plum and blackberry galette, perhaps with blueberry ice cream.
